Girls Age Rule Options

Girls have the option of racing two years below their real age. Thus a girl born in 2003 (age 14) has the option of racing with 12 year old boys. Ninety plus per cent of girls avail of this option in all three age groups (U12 U14 U16).

Alternatively a girl born in 2003 can elect to race with boys of her own age U14. However she will also be racing with girls aged 15 and 16 who have elected to race two years below their real age.

Girl racing two years below real age: Girl aged 14 would enter Category 3 U12 in entry form. With regard to gearing the girl must use gearing that applies to U12 (Category 3 and 3a).

Girl racing at real age: Girl Aged 14 would enter Category 2 U14 in entry form. With regard to gearing the girl must use gearing that applies to U14 (Category 2 and 2a)

Teams

A team must have a minimum of **three** riders to qualify as a team. The fastest three times will be selected from all the team's riders for each stage. Team prizes are only given out after the final stage. Irish registered riders should initially register as per their home club licence The managers of Irish composite provincial teams should advise race secretary of team selections.

Rules Re Gearing: Max roll out distances for one crank revolution are:

Category 1 and 1a	6.94mts (52 x 16)
Category 2 and 2a	6.54mts (49 x 16)
Category 3 and 3a	6.14mts (46 x 16)
